
What is Good Standing?

- ▶ Five (5) Levels of National Garden Clubs, Inc. Flower Show Judges
 - 1. Student Judge
 - 2. Accredited Judge
 - 3. Accredited Life Judge
 - 4. Accredited Master Judge
 - 5. Emeritus Master Judge (Contact the state Credentials Chair for assistance to apply for Emeritus Status).
- Good Standing A judge who is an active member of an NGC Garden Club, earns the required exhibiting and judging credits and refreshes at required intervals at approved Flower Show Schools or Symposiums.
- Good Standing Date The date your credentials expire unless you refresh or request an extension from the state Credentials Chair.

- The Directory lists Florida judges, name, address, telephone number, email address, District, Judges level and Good Standing Date.

- Corrections will be shared with the Executive Committee and the editor of Factual Notes.

How do you advance your good standing date?

- Refresh your credentials at a Symposium every 3 years to remain in good standing. (By Dec. 31st of the 3rd year from the date of your last Symposium)
- Accredited Judges (only) may take Flower Show School III or IV as an alternative to a Symposium and only one time.
- Submit your application to attend a refresher to the state Credentials Chair (Barb Jacobson) for approval 1 month before attending the refresher (6 weeks if attending an out of state Symposium or school).
- Your application may be mailed or scanned and submitted as an attachment to an email. Keep a copy and all documentation in your personal file.

Procedure to Refresh Credentials

- Accredited and Life Judges must register to take a Symposium for credit, attend all sessions, and take and pass the Horticulture and Design point scoring exams with a minimum score of 70.
- Master Judges must register to audit the Symposium. They do not point score but will receive credit if they attend all sessions.
- Following a Symposium the state Symposium Chair submits paperwork to NGC for Accreditation. The new Good Standing Date will be December 31 three (3) years from the Symposium date. Example: For the November 2022 Symposium, the new Good Standing Date is December 31, 2025.
- Paperwork will also be submitted to NGC for judges that are eligible to advance their status to the next level (Accredited to Life or Life to Master).
- Accredited and Life Judges earn one (1) Judging Credit when taking an NGC Symposium for credit. The Judge must take and pass the point scoring exams to receive this judging credit.

Forms For Recording Your Credits

Judges are responsible for maintaining their credentials records.

Keep a copy of your exhibiting and judging credit forms along with documentation to support them.

Keep a list of the refreshers you attend along with your graded point scoring sheets that are returned to you once the refresher is accredited by NGC.



Advancing to the Next Level

Accredited Judge Level 2

Refresh 3 x to advance to Accredited Life Judge

Pass point scoring (70+)

>= 4 months, <= 3 years

Accredited Life Judge Level 3

Refresh 2 x to advance to Accredited Master Judge

Pass point scoring (70+)

>=4 months, <= 3 years

Accredited Master Judge Level 4

Audit (no exam)
to maintain certification

Attend all sessions

<= 3 years









Requirements for Each Refresher

- Earn Judging Credits
 - NGC Standard or Small Standard Flower Show: Judge a minimum of 6 classes (1 class in Horticulture, 1 in Design, 4 classes in any Division except the Photography Section of the Botanical Arts Division.
 - Design Specialty Show: Judge three classes of Design or two classes of Design and one class in any other Division except the Photography Section of the Botanical Arts Division.
 - ► Horticulture Specialty Show: Judge at least one class in Horticulture and five classes in Horticulture, Education, Youth/Sponsored, or the Botanical Arts Division except the Photography Section of the Botanical Arts Division.
- Earn Exhibiting Credits

Judging Requirements for Each Refresher

Accredited

Judge 3 NGC Flower Shows (minimum of 6 classes)

One (1) Alternate judging credit allowed

- Serve on the Master Panel for a Flower Show School or Symposium & pass point scoring exams
- Serve on Evaluation Panel of an NGC Flower Show
- Chair 2 Flower Show School Courses or 1 Symposium

One (1) Excess Judging Credit may be carried over to the next refresher (earned in the year prior to refreshing but not needed to meet requirements)

Life

Judge 1 NGC Flower Show

(minimum of 6 classes)

Alternate judging credit:

- Serve on the Master Panel for a Flower Show School or Symposium & pass point scoring exams
- Serve on Evaluation Panel of an NGC Flower Show
- Chair 2 Flower Show School Courses or 1 Symposium

Master

Judge 1 NGC Flower Show

(minimum of 6 classes)

Alternate judging credit:

- Serve on the Master Panel for a Flower Show School or Symposium & receive passing grade on point scoring form
- Serve on Evaluation Panel of an NGC Flower Show



Exhibiting Requirements for Each Refresher

Accredited Judge

Earn at least 2 exhibiting credits for each year or part of a year between refreshers

- 1 ribbon in Horticulture
- 1 ribbon in Design
- One (1) Alternate exhibiting credit
- Give a horticulture or design program to a garden club, judges council, or gardenrelated organization
- Serve as chairman of small standard, standard, or specialty flower show

Life Judge

Earn 2 exhibiting credits for <u>each</u> year or part of a year between refreshers

- 1 ribbon in Horticulture (or Botanical Arts Horticulture)
- 1 ribbon in Design (or Botanical Arts Design including Exploration, or Artistic Crafts)

One (1) Alternate exhibiting credit

- Provide a horticulture or design exhibit for practice or written point scoring exam in an NGC Flower Show School or Symposium
- Serve as chairman of small standard, standard, or specialty flower show

Master Judge

Earn 2 exhibiting credits

- 1 ribbon in Horticulture (or Botanical Arts Horticulture)
- 1 ribbon in Design (or Botanical Arts Design including Exploration, or Artistic Crafts)

One (1) Alternate exhibiting credit

- Provide a horticulture or design exhibit for practice or written point scoring exam in an NGC Flower Show School or Symposium
- Serve as chairman of small standard, standard, or specialty flower show



Additional Exhibiting Credits for Accredited Judges

Must have at least one ribbon in Design and one ribbon in Horticulture from an NGC flower show between Refreshers.

Only one credit in Horticulture and one credit in Design may be counted for each flower show.



ADDITIONAL EXHIBITING CREDITS

May be used to meet requirements when there are multiple years between Refreshers.

- Earn exhibiting credits in any of the 4 Divisions: Horticulture, Design, Education, or Botanical Arts (except the Photography Section).
- Provide a judged or critiqued Horticulture or Design Exhibit for practice or written point scoring exam in an NGC Flower Show School or Symposium.
- Provide a Horticulture or Design Exhibit for a Judges Council, Arrangers Guild, or Study Group (Must be judged and point scored by Accredited Judges).
