•* **J-1 Junior Design Award**

Enter an original Blue Ribbon floral design at the NGC Standard Flower Show or any Youth Garden Show.

•** **J-2 Youth Flower Show**

Club must hold a Youth Flower Show or Youth can participate in an adult Standard Flower Show.

•** **J-3 School Grounds Beautification**

Club that shows the greatest improvement in an established garden OR helps contribute to the landscaping of a new school.

•** **J-4 Youth Horticulture Award**

Club that makes the most effort to plant and grow horticulture in an outdoor area.

•** **J-10 Classroom Project**

Environmental posters. Any environmental subject. All club members must be involved. May use computers.

•* **J-11 Litter Control Poster**

Student creating the best poster that presents a litter control idea.

•** **J-12 Land Trust Essay**

Write an Essay on the topic "Save Land for Tomorrow."

•** **J-13 JG Nature Posters**

Best group of posters on any nature subject.

•* **J-14 Water Conservation Poster**

Best creative poster bringing awareness to children about the importance of water and conserving it. Theme: We Love Our Water-Let's Save It.

•* **J-15 Louise Adams for Wekiva Youth Camp Report**

Best report on "My Week at Wekiva Youth Camp."

•* **J-16 Field Trip Report**

Describe a field trip. Include photos, maps, wildlife information native to the environment.

•** **J-20 Junior Horticulture**

Leader/teacher will suggest a project (growing plants, propagation, identify 25 plants, a study of poisonous plants, etc.) All members of club must participate and provide a written report.

•** **J-21 Poisonous Plants**

Detailed color drawings of 15 poisonous plants native to Southeast USA. Must include a guest speaker or program given to group with documentation.

•** **J-22 Pitcher Plant Preservation**

Best folder of club that prepares various drawings or colorings of pitcher plants. Each drawing must be done by different group members.

•** **J-23 Children's Garden**

Poster of your home garden with a story about why you like to garden and how you got interested in gardening.

•*** **J-24 Wildflower Folder**

Best creation of folder describing 5-10 wildflowers. Must include detailed original drawings, botanical names, and description of habitat.

•*** **J-25 Native Plants**

Portfolio of drawings or photos of native plants. Showing botanical details, correct identification etc.

•* **J-26 Native Trees of Florida**

Best description and illustration of native trees. Include map, soil preference, protection, propagation, and other details.

•* **J-27 Tree Award**

Picture of student with special tree. Write "Why This Tree Is Important To Me."

•* **J-30 Margaret Y. Pace Birds in Florida**

Folder describing 10-15 Florida birds.

•* **J-31 Aquatic Birds in Florida**

Folder on Florida Aquatic Birds.

•** **J-32 Butterfly Conservation Folder**

Booklet on Florida Butterflies.

•** **J-33 Protecting Pollinators**

Posters describing 3 (min.) different pollinators found in Florida. Describe importance and protection.

•* **J-34 Reptiles & Amphibians Found in Florida**

Folder to include 5-10 drawings.

•* **J-35 Garden Insects Found in Florida**

Folder to include 5-10 drawings.

•* **J-36 Shells In Florida**

Folder to include 6 pages (front only) description of shells.

•** **J-40 Junior Achievement**

Participation in flower show or conduct conservation, clean earth, nature picnic, or supporting a nature related organization.
