Since launching a partnership with U.S. Forest Service in 2004, National Garden Clubs, Inc. (NGC) and its various affiliates across the country have collected well over \$100,000 on the local and state level for the U.S. Forest Service's well-known Penny Pines program.

These donations are used by the USDA Forest service or State Forester to replant burnt or otherwise damaged trees in conjunction with federal funds. Seedlings are replacement and/or trees native to that particular area not necessarily of the pine variety. These funds have benefitted 80 national forests in 42 states.

Planting sites are selected by the Supervisor of each National Forest. These plantations provide soil protection, watershed protection, soil stabilization, future harvestable timber, as well as beauty and shade for recreation.

All our contributions go to our National Forests in the State of Florida!  
Contributions must be in increments of \$68 (which cover an acre of seedlings)

We need to promote education in conservation by creating public awareness of the need to protect and manage our National Forest resources. Let's all publicize our objectives and establish even more Penny Pines plantations for the reforestation of our National Forests.
