What's New for 2021?

The mission of SEEK is to increase student environmental literacy through hands on and field based educational experiences. To inspire student interest and involvement in environmental conservation and protection; and to promote student development of environmental stewardship ethics as well as environmental career opportunities.

The field excursions and experiential activities focus on exploring a UF Solar Farm, Devil's Millhopper Geological State Park (miniature rain forest) and O'Leno State Park (where the spring-fed Santa Fe River goes underground for 3 miles and reemerges in River Rise Preserve State Park). Wrapping up the program will be a UF Panel to discuss Environmental Science Careers and offerings at UF.
